Domestic Gas HEALTH AND SAFETY

Are You Moving or Altering Your Home?

When purchasing a property always ask about any gas appliances and installation to satisfy yourself that they have been suitably installed and regularly serviced by a CORGI registered gas installer.

When altering your property check with a registered installer or your gas supplier to confirm that any alterations will not have an adverse effect on the operation of your gas appliances by for example reducing ventilation.
